ROYAL ACCOLADES FOR THE EAST OF ENGLAND'S ENTERPRISING BUSINESSES ...

Her Majesty The Queen today announced the 2005 winners of The Queen's Award for Enterprise, the UK's leading accolade for business success that is now in its 40th year. There are 137 Awards, the highest total for 10 years.

In the East of England, Awards have gone to 24 companies, with the winners increasing from a total of 13 last year and two firms enjoying success in two categories.

The anniversary year is also marked by the announcement of the first recipients of The Queen's Award for Enterprise Promotion, a new individual Award for people who have played a significant role in promoting the growth of enterprise and/or entrepreneurial skills and attitudes in others. There is one recipient in the East of England; Professor Alan Barrell, based in Cambridge.

East of England winners of The Queen's Awards for Enterprise include an Essex company, over 100-years-old, that trades in the recycling and recovery of precious metals, a Cambridge-based printing company and two small companies from Peterborough and Hertfordshire - specialists in diesel engine generating sets and structural foundations - that
